






Can you tell us more about PentaPAC?

PAC is the only spot to get the PentaPAC badge and it comes in 2 levels. Being a 5 sided badge, there are 5 segments to it as follows:



Each segment of the PentaPAC will have a Gold & Silver level. You will be required to complete all 5 segments at the respective level to be awarded your PentaPAC badge.

Further details will be available in the PAC21 handbook sent out in November 2023.

When will you request further information?

By now, all those registered should have seen an invitation to Brigades Online which is the online management system we are utilising for this PAC. If you haven't received your invitation, please email pacamp@brigadeaustralia.org and we'll resend.

When will electives be released?

As per the timeline in the May '23 edition, these will be released early July. Electives will be allocated on a first in first serve basis.

I've heard there are camp clothes, how do we select?

Included in your camp fee are 2x camp shirts and 1x camp bucket hat. These are required to be worn when going for off-site activities. A laundry will be available at the campsite. Some campers decide to purchase extra shirts (extra cost will be invoiced).

As part of your response to elective preferences, we'll also ask your shirt size and whether you want additional shirts or hats.



How do I get to camp?

We encourage you to speak to others at your local company and consider travelling together. Please note, we are unable to supply lunch on the first day, however we are intending to operate the camp canteen. We'll also request your transport mode and arrival information as part of the elective preference response.



Are there transfers available?

For those travelling by plane or train, we will be offering included transfers from Canberra Airport/Train Station to the campsite on 3rd January and 11th January 2024. Best arrival times are 12noon to 4pm on 3/1/24 and for departure after 11am on 11/1/24.



Can I drive to the campsite?

Please arrive at the campsite from 1pm on 3rd January 2024. You are welcome to be dropped off but if you are intending on driving to the campsite (by bus/car), parking on-site is limited and must be pre-booked with Camp Admin.
